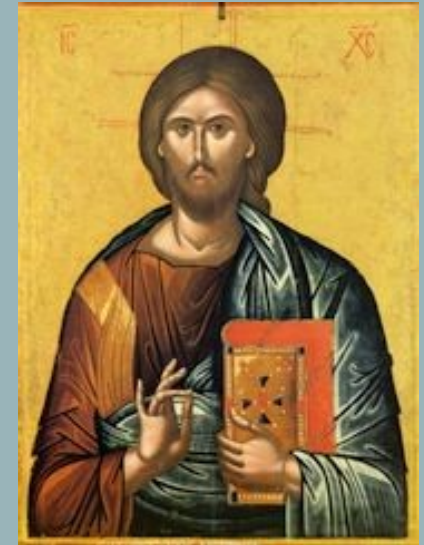

# Christian Mysticism: History Wisdom and Insights

- The course will survey key figures of the Christian mystical tradition. It offers a unique opportunity to explore in depth the history and wisdom of Christian mysticism. It is a structured course taught by leading scholars of different Christian denominations.
- Centering Prayer and Meditation will be an integral part of the course, but previous experience is not necessary.
- September 2008 begins the second of a three-year course. Those who did not attend year one are eligible to attend year two. Participants register for one year at a time. The classes are held from September through May.
- The **Colonial Hills United Methodist Church** will host this course, usually on the first Saturday of each month, from 9:00 am through 12:00 pm. It is located at **5247 Vance Jackson, San Antonio, TX, 78230.**
- The course is open to anyone of any spiritual tradition (or none) who wishes to explore Christian Mysticism seriously and in depth. No prior knowledge is required, but the course will best suit those who are prepared to give time for personal study. Registration is now open for the second year of the course.

**Year 1, September 2007—May 2008**, dealt with the foundations of mysticism through the Middle Ages. The topics included an introduction to Christian Mysticism, The Foundations of Mysticism in the Jewish Scriptures, Mysticism in the New Testament: John & Paul, Desert Mothers and Fathers, Origen and Clement of Alexandria, Augustine of Hippo, Byzantine Spirituality, Benedict, and Celtic Spirituality: Bridget, Columba, and Patrick.
