Qualifications

Demonstrated competence in organization, curriculum development, and teaching is expected. A successful candidate exhibits interest in the predominately Hispanic cultural milieu of the church in the Southwestern U.S. Fluency in Spanish is highly desirable. Knowledge in using Microsoft Office and online management systems is necessary.

Position Description

The position carries the rank of assistant or associate professor depending on experience and qualifications. Responsibilities include overseeing the D.Min. program, recruiting students, teaching, directing D.Min projects, curriculum development and revisions. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

OST, founded in 1903 by the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, is accredited by the Association of Theological Schools and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
