**Oblate School of Theology
Introduces**

2007 Fall Semester: Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology

The Vatican Congregation for Catholic Education has approved Oblate School of Theology's request to offer the Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology (S.T.B.) degree. The S.T.B. is offered through an affiliation with St. Paul University in Ottawa, Canada.

The S.T.B. degree provides graduate seminary students with an intensive, theological education and credentials to prepare them for the ministerial priesthood. The course of studies will be completed in four years with concentrations in historical and cultural studies, scripture, dogmatic theology, and pastoral studies. Final cumulative written and oral examinations are required for completion of the degree. Prerequisites include courses in philosophy and introductory theology.
