**Fr. John J. Markey, O.P., PhD.**, is currently the Director of the Doctor of Ministry Program at Oblate School of Theology. He received his doctorate in Theology and Philosophy from the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley, California. He published a book in 2004 entitled *Creating Communion: The Theology of the Constitutions of the Church*, and he has just finished writing a new book, *Moses in Pharaoh's House: A Liberation Spirituality for North Americans*, due out this year. Professor Markey is a member of the Order of Preachers (commonly called the Dominicans) and is originally from San Antonio.



**Rose Marden, MDiv**, is the Associate Dean for Continuing Education at Oblate School of Theology where she also lectures in pastoral theology. She has extensive experience in the area of catechesis and has offered workshops and adult faith formation programs throughout the diocese.
